



CHEVRON SIMPLICITY NECKLACE & EARRINGS

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I love the elegance simplicity in this jewelry set.

Skill level: Beginner and up

Techniques: Opening/closing jump rings

Finished length: Pendant 1" (without chain),
Earrings ½" (excluding ear wire)

MATERIALS

5-9 Chevron Duos in 3 colors

1 KATANO Cymbal™ pendant setting

2 RAMOS Cymbal settings

16-24" length of small link chain

1 pair ear wires

Clasp of choice

2-4 size 5mm jump rings

2 pairs of pliers

Jeweler's glue



TIP:

- Test that your Chevrons will fit into the bezel area before gluing them. Some bead finishes can be thicker than others.
- Make sure that jump rings fit through the chain links.

Step 1. Place several dots of glue into each bezel area of the KATANO and RAMOS settings and insert the Chevrons. **NOTE:** Do not overfill the bezel or the glue will overflow when the bead is added. Set them aside to allow the glue to dry.



Step 2. Fold chain in half to find the middle link, use pliers to open a jump ring, insert into the middle link of the chain. Add the KATANO pendant through the loop and close the jump ring. Use jump rings to attach the clasp to each end of the chain.

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Step 3. Use pliers to open an ear wire and insert into the loop of the RAMOS. Close the jump ring. Repeat to complete the second earring.

DESIGN OPTIONS (extra supplies may be needed):

If you like earrings that dangle, add a small length of chain before attaching the ear wire.

Use pliers to add a few extra RAMOS charms around the chain for a dressier necklace.
